License Law Changes – The legislature approved increases in the statutory caps for license exam fees to \$150 and annual E&O insurance premiums to \$250. The license exam and E&O insurance are both contracted with private companies through a competitive bidding process. Both contracts (with Pearson VUE and Rice Insurance Services Co., respectively) are up for renewal this year. Preliminary information from Rice indicates a \$10-\$20 annual premium increase – with some expanded coverage - for the next two-year period.
