

It's E&O Insurance Renewal Time! – Group E&O renewals are due this Friday, October 1st, NO EXCEPTIONS! We still have far too many licensees who haven't yet renewed. At this late date, the only way to ensure that Rice receives your renewal is to overnight a check or renew online at www.risceo.com (\$5 convenience fee will be added to your premium).

IREC Rule 121 was revised in 2010 to specifically state that any late renewal is considered a failure to maintain insurance, and will subject the licensee to a fine. There is NO grace period, and renewing late could also result in a gap in your coverage.
